Patagonian Panther Den, Sofía Cave 4

<i>Difficulty</i>	Low.
<i>Hiker's level</i>	Low.
<i>Duration</i>	Approximately 2,5 hours, depending on walking speed.
<i>Route</i>	Approximately 5 kilometers with altitudes ranging from 59 to 293 meters.
<i>Season</i>	From November to March.
Price	USD 10 per person.
<i>Description</i>	This route is ideal for family outings, including children, as it offers an easy-level trek. During the gentle ascent, you can enjoy an impressive view of the ancient lake, Laguna Sofía, and the Prat Mountain Range. Additionally, Cave 4 of Laguna Sofía served as an ancient den for the Patagonian panther during the Pleistocene era, with a depth of 6 meters. In this cave, remains of the ground sloth, saber-toothed tiger, guanacos, and other small species have been found.
<i>Signage</i>	The trail is fully marked with orange signs and trail markers to ensure clear and safe navigation.
<i>What to wear</i>	It is suggested to wear suitable footwear for walking on varied terrains, comfortable and weather-appropriate clothing, sun protection (hat, sunglasses, sunscreen), water, and snacks to stay hydrated and energized during the journey. Additionally, a lightweight backpack and hiking pole can be helpful.
<i>Transfers</i>	Service available upon request, not included in the entrance fee.
<i>Additional Information</i>	Hiking trail is self-guided.
