




# 6 HOURS Horseback Ride in Patagonia

## Condor viewpoint and centennial forest trail

<i>Difficulty</i>	Moderate – High.
<i>Rider's Age and Level</i>	From 10 to 70 years old, suitable for riders of low, intermediate, and advanced levels.
<i>Activity Duration</i>	Approximately 6 hours, including a warm and friendly welcome, equipment setup, induction, visit to the stables, riding demonstration and instruction, as well as organization for departure and arrival.
<i>Effective Riding Time</i>	4:30 hours approximately.
<i>Route</i>	Approximately 14 kilometers with altitudes ranging from 59 to 533 meters.
<i>Price</i>	<b>USD 180 per person. Includes lunch</b> and stop with an hour to eat approximately.
<i>Schedule</i>	Morning at 09:00 AM (in September and October at 10:00 AM).
<i>Specialized Staff</i>	The activity is carried out by Patagonian baqueanos (local cowboys), experts in the region and horse riding. These experienced guides carry a communication radio) and a first aid kit. A guide may lead up to 4 riders (1:4 ratio).
<i>Equipment</i>	Equestrian helmets, leather gaiters, and high-quality saddles with handmade leather saddlebags and sheepskin saddle pads are provided for the protection and safety of participants.
<i>What to wear</i>	It is suggested to wear a rain jacket and/or warm clothing, gloves, and closed-toe shoes with low to medium heels. The use of plastic ponchos, high-heeled footwear, shorts, selfie sticks, and drones is not recommended. Personal gloves are recommended.
<i>Breathtaking Views</i>	From the summit of Mirador Cóndor, at 533 meters above sea level, you will contemplate an epic panoramic view of the estancia, Puerto Natales, Última Esperanza Fjord, Dorotea Range, and the breathtaking beauty of Lake Sofía, Prat Mountain Range, and the native flora and fauna of Patagonia. Here, an important colony of condors adds its magnificence to this unparalleled natural spectacle. Patagonian weather is extreme and unpredictable: you may experience sun, wind, cold, rain, or snow. Activities are only cancelled in the event of heavy rain that compromises passenger safety.
